

Please use this official errata to complete and clarify the Gold Raiders rules as printed in the published first edition manual.

STACK ORIENTATION

While the sequence of the cards in each stack is relevant, the orientation of each stack does not matter when resolving it during the Day Phase. Players should use their best judgement and resolve each stack from top to bottom, or from bottom to top, in whichever orientation would move their Raider the farthest.

For example, stacks showing cards ordered 3-2-1 and 1-2-3 would both move your Raider six spaces forward. However, a 1-3-2 (or 2-3-1) would still only move your Raider forward one space.

FIRST PLAYER ROTATION

At the end of the Day Phase, pass the First Player Idol to the player that is farthest along the trail. If two or more players are tied for the farthest, pass the idol to the player closest in order to the current first player.
