

## *The '45 Errata (20 Sept. 1996)*

### **Counters**

The Hannoverian 14th Dragoons are the Hamilton's Dragoons listed in the scenario set ups.

The French leader Comte de Saxe is included for use in a future variant.

### **Reinforcements**

Jacobite Lord George Murray regiment [1 ] arrives at Box 6 Rannoch during the Rising of the Clans.

Sir Hector MacLean's regiment [1 ] is a conditional reinforcement as the counter and Undecided Clans chart indicate.

Only those forces listed as available at Edinburgh are contingent upon declaring the king in Lowland Scotland.

Charles Murray regiment [1] appears in Box 16 Stirling upon declaring the king in Northeast/Central Scotland.

Leader Lord Gordon appears 1 October 1745 at Aberdeen.

### **Map**

The Hannoverian leader Wade is not a royal leader.

### **Rules**

**12.2** The highest ranking leader in a stack is its commander. **13.1** Jacobite units are not subject to attrition until the Jacobite player raises the standard or the August III 1745 turn, whichever comes first.

**14.51** An engineer leader who is also commanding his force does not get to add his bonus twice when attacking.

**17.13** This refers to 25 percent of total SPs, not total units. **17.4** Jacobites may desert after a successful assault on an enemy fortification.

**17.7** Leaders without troops are restricted as well (unless they move to join Wade).

**19.2** Yes, the Hannoverian can win the campaign game in the first two minutes by sinking Prince Charlie.

**20.11/12** These movement restrictions apply to the campaign game as well.

**Winter:** All months with two turns are winter months (for attrition and forced march purposes).

### **Charts**

The skirmish table is only used during scenario six.
